RULES

Rules will be conducted by the JLA Competition Manual 2019 (ILS Competition Manual 2015-2019 (2017ver, latest ILS manual))

ENTRY FOR INTERNATIONAL COMPETITORS

Should comply with the competition regulations as follows.

AWARDS

Awards for 1st to 8th for each event. Medals for 1st to 3rd. No overall awards.

TEAM MANAGERS MEETING

Competitors or representatives of international teams shall attend briefing at 9:00am on Sat, 15th June. Details will be informed later.



ENTRY FEE & PAYMENT

8,000 yen per competitor up to 2 events. For more than 3 events additional fee of 1,000 yen per event.

International Competitors shall pay the entry fee before the commencement of the event, which can be paid in cash on the competition day.

No change can be made concerning entry.

EQUIPMENTS/GEARS

The Organizing Committee will provide a pool of equipment's/gears for international competitors. Surf skis, boards, and tubes. Please contact Shin Suzuki (Mr.) for fee and details.

The 32nd Japan National Individual Lifesaving Championship (for international competitors) Competition Regulations

1. ELIGIBILITY & RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE

- 1-1 Lifesavers who have demonstrated a commitment to lifesaving.
- 1-2 Competitors should be over 12 on the first day of the competition.

2. TEAM MANAGER

The team should have one Team Manger. A Team Manager could be a competitor. The team manager should participate in the Team Managers meeting. If the Team Manager cannot participate in the TM meeting a competitor from the team can replace.

3. TEAM UNIFORMS

- 3-1 The team should wear appropriate team uniforms, swim wear and caps during ceremonies and competition.
- 3-2 If JLA judges the design of the uniform, swim wear and cap is inappropriate, no competitor can compete.
- 3-3 **The design of the Team Caps should be sent to JLA by 15th May.**
- 3-4 All the members of the team should wear the same designed cap. If the design is different from the Ocean and the Pool it should be registered in advance.
At the start of the event the cap should be tied under the chin.
- 3-5 If the team uniform, swim wear, cap and rash vest design offends the sponsor of the competition, the team should follow the organizers direction.
- 3-6 **Competitors must wear rash vests in surf events.**
No one can compete without rash vests. Please bring your own rash vest.
Rash vests should be visible with colors as pink, orange yellow, green or red.

4. EQUIPMENTS

- 4-1 The equipment specification should apply to the ILS competition rule book 2015-2019.
- 4-2 The organizer can scrutineer the equipment prior to its use in events, and, if necessary, during and/or after an event. If the equipment does not apply to the standard, the competitor cannot use the equipment or will be DQ.

5. COMPETITION REGULATIONS

Rules will be conducted according to the JLA Competing Regulations 2019 which is in accordance to ILS rules 2017-2019 and additional information below.

- 5-1 This competition begins at the marshal time of the first event and finishes 20 minutes after the end of the last event. However, if there are any protest or appeals, the competition will continue until the complete resolution.
- 5-2 By entering, the competitors are regarded to have responsibility and obligation to know the regulations and the process of managing the competition.



5-3 The competitors cannot wear video cameras. Also, any other devices cannot be attached to the competitor.

5-4 The competitors cannot use electronic devices from the beginning to the end of the race.

5-5 A protest concerning beach flags should be before the next run through.

5-6 Only A finals are conducted

5-7 Handlers must come to the marshal with the competitor at marshal time

6. **OTHERS**

6-1. Photos and videos taken by the organizer and/or authorized people will be used for PR.

6-2. The organizer can limit or stop others from taking photos or videos and can ask for the record.

6-3. If there is any false information in the documents that are submitted, entries and/or results could be revoked.
