Dear friends,

#### **Facts**

1. *The world is facing a pandemic situation which affects nearly all countries, including all ILS Member Organisations.*
2. *Italy, and especially Northern Italy has nowadays been heavily affected by Covid-19 with no respite in sight and the region around Riccione is one of the most affected.*
3. *There is a widespread restriction on International travel and a massive cancellation of flights, and we do not know when that situation will be normalised.*
4. *There is a lack of available travel insurance. Because Covid-19 disease is known, no insurance company will cover people that become infected in at-risk zones.*
5. *The social distancing requirements and the decreasing number of people that can constitute a mass gathering will not allow spectatorship and will therefore reduce or even remove the world-wide impact of the Lifesaving World Championships.*
6. *Many national lifesaving championships are cancelled, which results in no possibility to select teams and to prepare them.*
7. *Many swimming pools are closed, which affect the training and the preparation of our competitors.*
8. *The age of many of our technical officials and delegates (35% is older than 60) is high and this group is identified as the high-risk group.*
9. *The economic impact of Covid-19 on our National Federations is significant. Many will be in recession as a result of the virus outbreak, particularly our low- and middle-income Nations.*
10. *We do not know what the impact of Covid-19 will be in 6-12 months' time, given it did not exist 4 months ago. It is predicted by scientists that the peak crisis in Europe will be in the spring of 2020 and that the peak crisis in many African, South American and Asia-Pacific countries will be in the summertime and autumn 2020. It is foreseen that the situation will*

be “normalised” at the start of 2021 if we count a possible re-appearance of Covid-19 in some countries where the disease was passed. It might be possible that medication or a vaccine is available in early 2021.

### **Concerns**

The main concern of the ILS is the health and well-being of our members, delegates, technical and team officials, competitors, volunteers, workforce, spectators, etc.

### **Crisis Management Group**

The Covid-19 Crisis Management Group was created urgently yesterday to take on the work of a smaller group that was monitoring and managing on a daily basis the Covid-19 issues since January 2020. The Crisis Management Group is composed of the ILS Chancellery, the LWC 2020 & 2022 Hosts, the ILS Sport Commission Chair & Secretary, the ILS Executive Director, the ILS Events Director, the ILS Legal Advisor and the ILS Financial Advisor.


### **Conclusion**
